It's safe to say The Woodlands girls basketball team is off to a good start.

The Lady Highlanders closed out the 62nd annual Conroe Tigerette Basketball Tournament with a 47-37 win over Cy-Creek Saturday to go undefeated in the tournament and bring home the championship.

"It is good to win but we have high expectations for ourselves," TWHS coach Dana Bruton said. "This is a long season and there are still a lot of things we want to accomplish."

Sophomore center Kelsey Lang paced The Woodlands (4-0) with 14 points against Cy-Creek and while it was the sophomore's scoring that led the offense, she also had four blocks to shut down the paint against the Lady Cougars.

Lang finished the tournament with 18 blocks.

"She is going to be a force in the area," Bruton said of Lang. "Teams are going to have to deal with her ability to block shots. She has a good instinct for it and she is going to continue to get stronger as the season goes on."

Junior point guard Paige Bradley had 11 points, five assists and four steals against Cy-Creek and was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player after the game.

"Paige had a great tournament," Bruton said. "She is one of the top point guards in the Houston area. She calls the offenses and defenses. I think the award is fair recognition for the effort that she showed during the tournament."

Maddy McGlamery led Cy-Creek with 15 points in the game – 10 of which came in the fourth quarter.

During the fourth quarter Cy-Creek battled back from being nine down to cut the game to three points but back-to-back baskets from Lang and Bradley helped end any hopes of a comeback from the Lady Cougars.

"I wasn't too worried," Bruton said. "I have a lot of confidence in our team so I felt good about our girls."

The Woodlands' Anna Strickland and Ashlyn Hargraves both were named to the All-Tournament team after the game.

The Lady Highlanders shot 44 percent from the field and made 4 of 7 shots from beyond the arc.

Also in action Saturday was College Park who knocked off Klein Oak 41-35. Alexia Sanders had 16 points while Megan Shafer pitched in 13 as the Lady Cavaliers took third in the tournament.
