## HBU basketball signs two, including College Park's Ryan

Sam Ryan, a 6-foot-10 post from College Park has signed a national letter of intent to play at Houston Baptist, men's basketball coach Ron Cottrell said Tuesday.

The Huskies also signed Samuel Obetoh, a 6-7 wing from Brooklyn, N.Y.

"We are very excited to be adding these two young men to our program," Cottrell said. "They are terrific young men and as we continue our transition to NCAA Division I, I believe they will help us continue to improve our program and achieve our goals of a conference championship and post-season play."

Ryan averaged 3.2 points, 4.4 rebounds and 1.3 blocked shot to help College Park advance to the second round of the Class 5A state playoffs.

"The biggest thing with Sam is adding size at the post position with a local young man," Cottrell said. "He comes from a very good local high school basketball program and he comes from a wonderful family. I'm excited to have him join our program and I am looking forward to his growth and development as a player at HBU."

Obetoh will transfer from Kaskaskia College, where he averaged 11.6 points and 3.4 rebounds as a sophomore last season.

"Sammy is a very athletic, long wing player who can really score, both from the perimeter and through his ability to penetrate off the dribble," Cottrell said. "He gives us some much needed size on the wing and can play multiple positions. We expect him to come in and make major contributions to our program over the next two years."

HBU went 12-21 in 2009-10, its third year transitioning to Division I. The Huskies finished in second place in the Great West Conference at 9-3.
